**AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE STOPPING, STANDING OR PARKING OF VEHICLES IN THE TOWN OF POLK, WASHINGTON COUNTY, WISCONSIN**

STATE OF WISCONSIN

Town of Polk, Washington County

The Town Board of the Town of the Town of Polk, Washington County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under **s. 349.13**, Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance.

The Town Board of the Town of Town of Polk, by this ordinance, adopted on proper notice with a quorum and by a roll call vote by a majority of the Town Board present and voting, provides the authority for the Town to regulate the stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles on town highways in the town as follows:

A. The no parking of vehicles on the following town highways in the Town of Polk is subject to the following restrictions and limitations. No parking from Cedar Creek Road on the north side of the road from a point starting at the intersection of Lily Road and Cedar Creek Road and ending 500 feet west, in Section 10 in the Town of Polk.

B. The town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs on the above-described highways on or before the effective date of this ordinance.

C. No persons may operate any vehicle on the above-noted Town highways, in violation of the above-noted stopping, standing, or parking restrictions and limitations. Any violation shall be subject to a forfeiture provided for in the Code of Ordinance, Chapter 7, Code #7.11 of the Town of Polk Traffic Code.

This ordinance is effective upon publication and posting *or* February 8, 2008
