Public Information Meeting for improvements to CTH C in the Town of Polk, Washington County

Proposed transportation improvements

Washington County will be reconstructing CTH C in the Town of Polk, Washington County. The project is scheduled to begin June 1, 2017 and be substantially completed by September 15, 2017. In effort to encourage collaboration and open communication among project leaders and local residents and businesses, the Washington County Highway Department will be holding a third Public Informational Meeting for the project. The purpose of the meeting is to provide an overview of the construction plans, discuss the timeline for the project as well as access and detour plans.

The project begins at American Eagle Drive and extends northeasterly to CTH Z. The project consists of reconstructing the existing roadway to address the deteriorating pavement and inadequate sight distance throughout the project length. Specific improvements include converting the CTH C/Hillside Road/Stoney Lane intersection to an all-way stop controlled intersection, replacement of the culvert carrying CTH C over Cedar Creek, and improvements to the CTH C/Cedar Creek Road/Lily Road intersection geometry. The roadway will be closed to through traffic during construction with detour alterations anticipated during various stages of construction.

Design consultants (Gremmer & Associates, Inc.), construction contractors (Wondra Construction), and inspection contractors (R.A. Smith National) will be on hand to explain the proposed improvements and construction schedule. Representatives from the Washington County Highway Department will also be available. Project plans will be on display to illustrate the work in detail.
