

**RESOLUTION #2017-06**  
**TOWN OF POLK**  
**Annual Noxious Weeds Summary**

Pursuant to Section 10.03(6) Noxious Weeds of the Town of Polk's Code of Ordinances, in Washington County, State of Wisconsin and Wisconsin Statute 66.0407:

Every person is required by law to destroy all of the following noxious weeds as defined by Section 66.0407 of the Wisconsin Statutes on lands in the Town of Polk, Washington County, Wisconsin, which the person owns, occupies, or controls.

The term "noxious weeds" includes the following:

1. Leafy Spurge
2. Canadian Thistle
3. Field Bindweed
4. Burdock
5. Garlic Mustard
6. Wild Parsnip
7. Those plants, which are infectious or poisonous in nature in or adjacent to populated areas.
8. All weeds enumerated in Section 23.235 and 66.0407 of the Wis Stats.
9. Any weed designated as a noxious weed by the Department of Natural Resources by rule, and or any other weed the Town Board of the Town of Polk or the County Board of Washington County by ordinance or resolution declares to be noxious within its respective boundaries.


This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage. Dated June 13, 2017.
